This funding will be used to


- Ensure that all students in Year 3 and 5 meet National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Reading or have a documented support plan in place.

Our initiatives include

- Employment of a full time Reading Coach to further develop the pedagogical and data literacy skills of all teachers.
- Implementation of Daily Rapid Reading and the Reading Link Program (Dr Carol Christensen) by the employment of additional teacher aides to deliver the program to all students in Prep – Year 5
- Ongoing professional development from external providers to enhance reading pedagogy for all staff
- Release of staff to view best practice in other sites and develop best practice networks.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Engaging teacher aides for the delivery of Oral Language and Phonological Awareness Support in Prep to Year 5. | \$ 40,000 |
| • Provision of additional teacher aide support to implement Daily Rapid Reading and Reading Links. | \$ 80,000 |
| • Engagement of a Reading coach to oversee student reading improvements. | \$ 42,000 |
| • Supporting staff release to view best practice and receive feedback on their classroom practices. | \$ 5,000 |
| • Purchasing resources to support the extension and intervention Daily Rapid Reading program. | \$ 5,000 |
